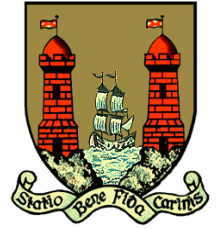

RE: SECTION 38, ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1994

Cork City Council proposes to carry out various measures to provide a safe high quality route with an increased level of service for Pedestrians and Cyclists at Horgan's Quay and Water Street. The main features of the proposed scheme are:-

- The provision of an inbound cycle lane on Water Street and Horgan's Quay to complement the existing lanes on Lower Glanmire Road and Penrose Quay.
- The upgrading of footpaths where required.
- Improvements to junctions to enhance safety for pedestrians and cyclists.
- Improvements to public lighting.
- The provision of street furniture, lighting and signage as required.

Details of the proposed works including an Appropriate Assessment screening report and Environmental Assessment screening report are available for inspection online at <https://consult.corkcity.ie> and also at Reception Desk, City Hall on working days from **Friday the 14th Feb 2020 to Monday the 16th March, 2020 from 9am to 4.30pm.**
