



Proposal Summary:

Background
 TFI Bus Stop No. 243101 is on the southern side of the R849 Glasheen Road in the townland of Clashduff. The stop is served by the westbound part of bus route No. 216. The facilities present do not allow the bus stop function effectively or safely due several factors:

- the bus stop lacks adequate road markings, meaning cars routinely park in front of the bus stop pole, preventing the bus from pulling in close to the kerb.
- passengers must pass between parked cars when boarding and alighting, which is hazardous.
- the bus stop is not accessible to people with buggies, wheelchair users, or people with mobility difficulties.

Proposed Improvement Works

It is now proposed to carry out works to provide improved facilities at the bus stop to make it safer, more accessible and more convenient for bus passengers. The improvement works will include the following:

- the bus stop location will be moved approximately 14m further west
- the footpath at the new stop will be reconstructed to include a built-out bus "boarder". The boarder will project approx 2.2m further into the roadway than the existing footpath/kerb. The boarder will be 12m long along the new kerbline adjacent to the roadway.
- Bus stop road markings and a new TFI type bus pole will be provided at the new bus stop.
- Other ancillary improvements may also be made, such as: replacement and additional road markings and road traffic signage, road drainage alterations etc.

The existing eastbound (city centre bound) bus stop will remain unchanged.
 All layouts and details are indicative for consultation purposes and may be subject to change.
