NOTICE UNDER SECTION 38 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1994 [AS AMENDED]

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act 1994 (as amended), Cork City Council hereby gives notice of its intention to carry out the following traffic management measures, in the interest of the safety and convenience of road users.

Cooney's Lane Pedestrian Improvement Scheme

It is proposed to provide a safe high-quality pedestrian network on the L-2461 through Cooney's Lane. The main features of the proposed Scheme are to:

- Improve existing pedestrian facilities to ensure provision of continuous footpaths along Cooney's Lane.
- Provide new uncontrolled pedestrian crossings at Grange Vale Court, Hollyville, Hillside, Ashford Court, Newton Court, Ardfield Road, Ardfield Grove, Ardfield and Bellevue Junction.
- Upgrade the existing pedestrian crossings near the entrance to Newton Court and the entrance to Hillside on Cooney's Lane, from uncontrolled crossings to controlled crossings.
- Reduce corner radii and narrow junctions at Grange Vale Court, Hollyville, Hillside, Ashford Court, Newton Court, Ardfield Road, Ardfield Grove, Ardfield and Bellevue Junction.
- Install traffic calming measures along Cooney's Lane to include lane narrowing, tightening corner radii and narrowing junctions, raised tables, line-marking and signage, as detailed in the Drawings included with this Notice.
- Improve public lighting in the area.
- Provide the necessary ancillary works - drainage, signage, line-marking, landscaping, etc., required as part of this Scheme, as detailed in the Drawings included with this Notice.

In accordance with the Habitats Directive, an **Appropriate Assessment (AA)** Screening has been carried out in relation to any potential impact these proposals may have upon the Cork Harbour Special Protection Area [Site No. 004030], and the Great Island Channel Special Area of Conservation [Site No. 001058]. The findings of the AA screening noted that no significant effects on any Natura 2000 site are likely, and it is not necessary to undertake any further stage of the Appropriate Assessment process.

In addition, the proposed Scheme has been screened to determine whether an **Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA)** is required, and it has been concluded that there will be no real likelihood of significant effects on the environment arising from the proposed Scheme, and an EIA is not required.

Accordingly, they will be included in the minutes of that meeting and may appear in the public domain. Cork City Council will retain data for no longer than is necessary and in accordance with the Council's Retention Policy and relevant Data Protection legislation.

APPLICATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY FOR THE REVIEW OF A LICENCE

In accordance with the E.P.A. Act 1992 as amended, Janssen Sciences Ireland UC intends to apply to the Environmental Protection Agency (E.P.A.) for the review of the industrial emissions licence P0778-02 for the installation at Barnahely, Ringaskiddy, Co. Cork (National Grid Reference 176901E, 064157N).

The class of activity applicable to this facility in accordance with the First Schedule to the EPA Act of 1992, as amended, is as follows:

Activity Class 5.16 "The production of pharmaceutical products including intermediates"

Activity Class 2.1 "Combustion of fuels in installations with a total rated thermal input of 50 MW or more." (additional activity class associated with the licence review)


An Environmental Impact Assessment Report relating to the planned changes to the site has been submitted to Cork County Council Planning Authority (Planning Application Ref 25/04704).

The environmental impact assessment report submitted to the Agency in accordance with section 83(2A)(d) of the Act of 1992, any information provided to the Agency under paragraph (e) or (f)(ii)(II) of section 83(2A) of the Act of 1992, any opinion issued by the Agency under section 83(2A)(de) of the Act of 1992 on the scope of the environmental impact assessment report, and any further information, including reports and advice, relating to the environmental impact assessment as may be furnished to the Agency in the course of the Agency's consideration of the application, shall each be made available on the Agency's website and at the headquarters of the Agency. Submissions may be made in writing to the Agency in relation to the likely effects on the environment of the proposed activity within the period specified by the Agency on its website under Regulation 4(2)(c). In accordance with section 87(2) of the Act of 1992, a proposed determination shall be published by the Agency on its website.

A copy of the application for the licence review may be inspected on the Agency's website (www.epa.ie) or inspected at or obtained from the headquarters of the Agency as soon as is practicable after the receipt by the Agency of the application for the licence.
