National Mobility Hubs Pilot – Cork City

Appropriate Assessment (AA) Screening Determination under the EU's Habitats Directive 92/43/EEC Article 6(3) as transposed into Irish law under Regulation 42(1) of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 (S.I. No. 477/2011), as amended

A screening determination for the need for **Appropriate Assessment (AA)** has been made by Cork City Council in respect of the scheme in accordance with the requirements of Article 6(3) of the Directive 92/43/EEC (Habitats Directives) and Regulation 42(1) of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 (as amended).

Stage 1 Screening for AA of the National Mobility Hubs Pilot – Cork City scheme has been carried out. The effects that could arise from the scheme have been examined, and on the basis of the findings, it is concluded that the scheme will not have significant adverse effects on any European Site. It is further concluded that the proposed scheme will not give rise to any adverse effects on designated European sites, alone or in combination with other plans or projects. Consequently, a Stage 2 AA is not required for the scheme.

This determination has been made following consideration of the information contained in an AA Screening Report for the scheme. Taking account of this report, it is determined that a full AA is not required to be undertaken for the National Mobility Hubs Pilot – Cork City scheme
