



Particulars of the proposed event:

The event is titled Cork Carnival of Science. The proposed event will take place at Fitzgerald's Park, Cork City on Saturday the 22nd and Sunday the 23rd of June 2019 between the hours of 11am to 6pm each day.

The event will be a free entry, two day event of educational interest with peripheral entertainment and food. It is expected to attract a crowd of 5,000 people each day consisting of family groups and people of all

# IMPROVEMENT WORKS: WILTON CORRIDOR PHASE 1: DENNEHY'S CROSS TO WILTON GARDENS

Cork City Council propose to carry out improvement works at Dennehy's Cross From the Junction of Wilton Road/Model Farm Road/Magazine Road Junction to the Wilton Gardens Junction

The objective of the project is to deliver enhanced, safe and appropriate transportation infrastructure aimed at providing sufficient capacity to meet current and future travel demand in the area with particular focus on facilities for sustainable modes of transportation. The project forms part of the larger Wilton Corridor Project which will provide a quality road connection between Wilton and the City centre for all users particularly those using sustainable transport modes.

To achieve these aims, it will be necessary to make the following modifications to the road layout:-

- Sections of Wilton Road to the north and south of Dennehy's Cross will be repaved and measures such as cycle lanes and bus lanes will be introduced where feasible within the extent of the study area
- Dennehy's Cross will be realigned, renewed, widened and additional lanes introduced. To achieve these aims it will be necessary to acquire additional land on all approaches to Dennehy's Cross
- All bus stops along the route will be upgraded and real time passenger information displays installed
- Footpaths will be realigned repaved and widened where necessary
- Carriageways will repaved and relined where
- Wilton Gardens junction with Wilton Road will be upgraded to a signalised junction with pedestrian crossing phase included.
- Right turning of vehicles from Wilton Road onto Magazine Road will be prohibited.
- Additional Public Lighting will be installed where
- Traffic signals will be renewed where necessary
- Hard & Soft landscaping will be provided
- Utility Services such as water mains, drains, ducting etc will be renewed
