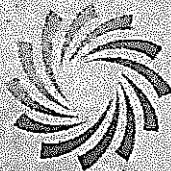

MAHON CYCLE SCHEME NOTICE UNDER SECTION 38 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1994

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act 1994, Cork City Council hereby gives notice of its intention to carry out the following traffic management measures on Ringmahon Road, Avenue de Rennes, Skehard Road, Ballinsheen Road, Sean Cronin Park, Ashwood, Mahon Drive, Lakeland Crescent, Loughmahon Road, Loughmahon Park and Castle Road, for the safety and convenience of road users.

The main elements of the proposed Mahon Cycle Scheme are:

- Renewal of footpaths and enhancements to the public realm.
- Installation of upgraded controlled pedestrian crossing facilities.
- Installation of raised table-top ramps and uncontrolled crossing facilities at junctions.
- Installation of circa 5.3 km of cycle infrastructure, including segregated cycle tracks and greenways.
- Signalisation of junctions at Ringmahon Road West/Skehard Road, Ringmahon Road/Avenue de Rennes and Skehard Road/Avenue de Rennes.
- Adjustments to the existing road layout, including traffic lanes, parking areas and new road markings and signage.
- Other necessary associated works.

In accordance with the Habitats Directive, an **Appropriate Assessment Screening** has been carried out on the project, in relation to any potential impacts upon the Cork Harbour Special Protection Area (Site No. 004030) and the Great Island Channel Special Area of Conservation (Site No. 001058). The findings of the AA screening noted that no significant effects on any Natura 2000 sites is likely and it was not necessary to undertake any further stage of the Appropriate Assessment process. Cork City Council accepts these findings.

In addition, the proposed development has been screened to determine whether an **Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA)** is required and it has been concluded that there will be no real likelihood of significant effects on the environment arising from the proposed development and an EIA is not required. Cork City Council accepts these findings.

Alternatively, the Plans & Particulars will be available for inspection on working days from Friday, 29th April to Monday, 30th May 2022 between 9.00am and 4.00pm at Reception Desk, Cork City Council, City Hall, Cork.

The final date for submissions is 5.00pm on Tuesday, 14th June 2022.

All comments, including names and addresses of those making submissions and observations, submitted to Cork City Council in regard to this scheme, will form part of the statutorily required report to be presented at the monthly meeting of Cork City Council. Accordingly, they will be included in the minutes of that meeting and may appear in the public domain. Cork City Council will retain data for no longer than is necessary and in accordance with the Council's Retention Policy and relevant Data Protection legislation.
