
RE: **Determination on the requirement for Appropriate Assessment for the proposed Marina Park Phase 2**

I refer to the above and confirm that I have considered the document titled “AA Screening Report Marina Park Phase II” for this project



I am satisfied that the proposed development is unlikely to have an effect on any Natura 2000 sites including the Cork Harbours SPA (004030) and the Great Island Channel cSPA (001058), and recommend that a determination be made that it is not necessary to undertake any further stage of the Appropriate Assessment Process.


