On the recommendations of John Stapleton, Acting Director of Service, Infrastructure Development and having considered the document titled "AA Screening Report Glanmire to City Cycle Route Phase 1" for this project I have noted that the Appropriate Assessment Screening report contains a comprehensive analysis in accordance with the EU Habitats Directive (92/43/EEC and Section 177 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 as amended.

I am satisfied that the proposed development is unlikely to have an effect on any Natura 2000 sites, including the Cork Harbour SPA (004030) and the Great Island Channel cSAC (001058), and therefore deem that it is not necessary to undertake any further stage of the Appropriate Assessment Process.

Accordingly, the proposed development shall proceed subject to the provisions of Section 179 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 as amended and the provisions of Part 8 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 as amended.


RE: Determination on the requirement for Appropriate Assessment for the proposed scheme Glanmire to City Cycle Route (Phase 1)
