Take notice that Cork City Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 101(7) of the Road Traffic Act 1961 as amended by Section 6 of and the Schedule to the Road Traffic Act 1968 and by Sections 4 and 49 (1) (i) of the Road Traffic Act 1994, proposes to make the above-entitled Bye-Laws regulating the use of a car park provided by it in the City of Cork, and in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 36 of the Road Traffic Act, 1994, proposes to make the above-entitled Bye-Laws controlling and regulating the parking of vehicles.
