
RE: Determination on the requirement for Appropriate Assessment for the proposed Anglesea Street Contraflow Bus Lane

I refer to the above and confirm that I have considered the document titled "Anglesea Street Contraflow Bus Lane AA Screening Report" for this project.


I have noted that the Appropriate Assessment Screening report contains a comprehensive analysis in accordance with the EU Habitats Directive (92/43/EEC) and Section 177 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 as amended.

I am satisfied that the proposed development is unlikely to have an effect on any Natura 2000 sites, including the Cork Harbour SPA (004030) and the Great Island Channel SAC (001058), and recommend that a determination be made that it is not necessary to undertake any further stage of the Appropriate Assessment Process.

I also recommend that the development proceed subject to the provisions of section 38 of the Roads Traffic Act 1994, as amended.
