NOTICE UNDER SECTION 37 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC
ACT 1994 (AS AMENDED)
Proposed Weight Restriction (Traffic Management)
for Richmond Hill

Under section 37 of the Road Traffic Act 1994 (as amended) a Road Authority may after consultation with the Commissioner, provide for public roads in their charge such regulatory signs as they consider desirable. Cork City Council now proposes to introduce a maximum vehicle weight restriction (traffic management) of 3.5 tonnes on Richmond Hill.

Plans and particulars of the proposed restriction will be available for public inspection from **Friday 01st of May of 2026** until **Tuesday 02nd June 2026**:

The deadline for receipt of submissions and observations is **5:00 pm on Tuesday 02nd June 2026**.

All comments, including names and addresses of those making submissions and observations, submitted to Cork City Council in regard to this proposal, will form part of the statutory required report to be presented at the monthly meeting of Cork City Council. Accordingly, they will be included in the minutes of that meeting and may appear in the public domain. Cork City Council will retain data for no longer than is necessary and in accordance with the Council's Retention Policy and relevant Data Protection legislation.
