What is a submission?

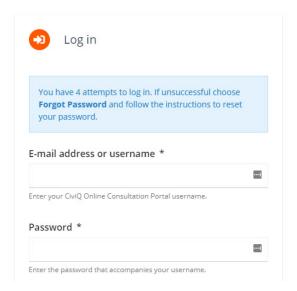
A submission captures your views and opinions about a particular consultation. This online submission process enables you to make comments against the various themes and maps of the comment based consultation document.

You may make as many observations as you like in your submission. You can also attach files such as documents, maps and photos.

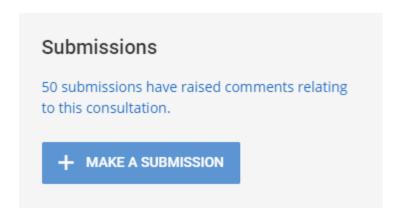
Having completed your observations, you can then outline your areas of interest related to your submission/observations on the interactive map.

Log in using your password.



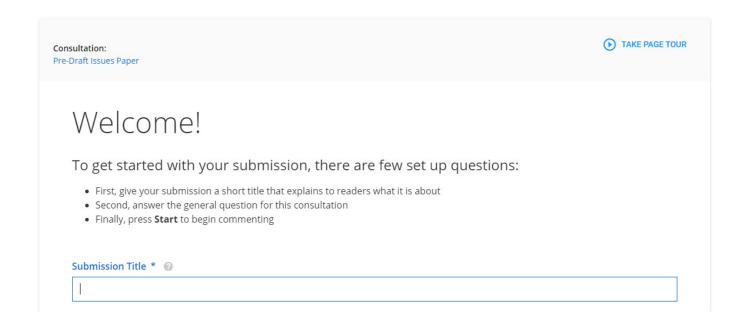
Click on the cosultation tab then click on the consultation you are interested in and on the icon **Make a Submission**.

You may also Take a page tour.

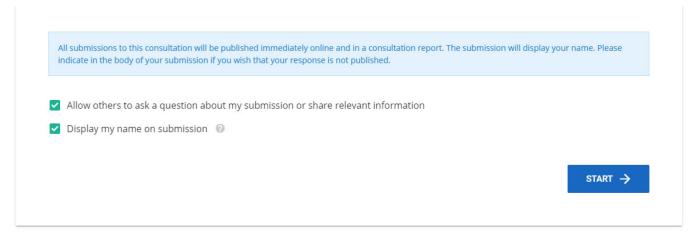

Comments

This is the section of the document where you make you comments on the consultation. A comment is an individual observation about a specific theme within the consultation document.

Themes

First select the theme you wish to address from the drop down list.

When you choose a theme you will be given the option to read that chapter in full before making your observation. You should create individual comments every time you want to provide a comment about a topic within the consultation. You may add as many observations as you wish.



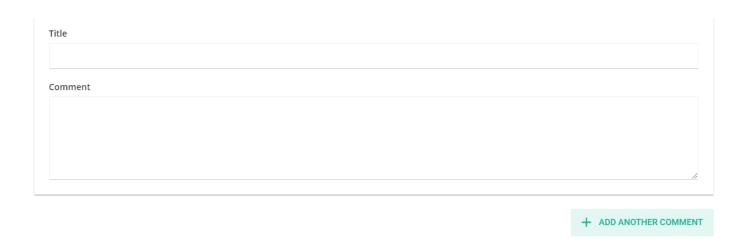
Summary Title for your comment

The title should represent a summary of the content of the comment, similar to the subject line of an email.

Your Comment

This is where you make your observations. Type or paste the main content of an individual comment into this box. You should create a new observation every time you have a comment that is unrelated in topic or chapter to another observation.

You have the option to add another comment by clicking the **Add Another Comment** tab.



Add Attachments

Here you are offered the option to add attachments your submission.

You can add a maximum of five attachments.

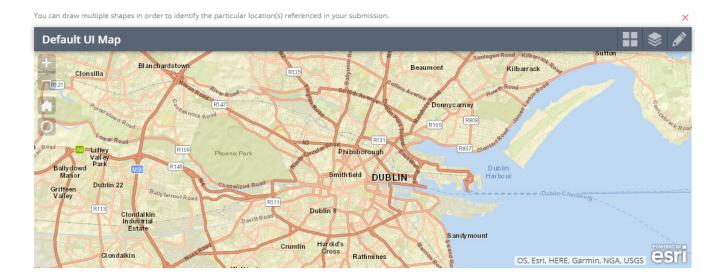


Mark / Outline your area of interest on the interactive map [optional]

You can indicate areas related to your submission on an interactive map.

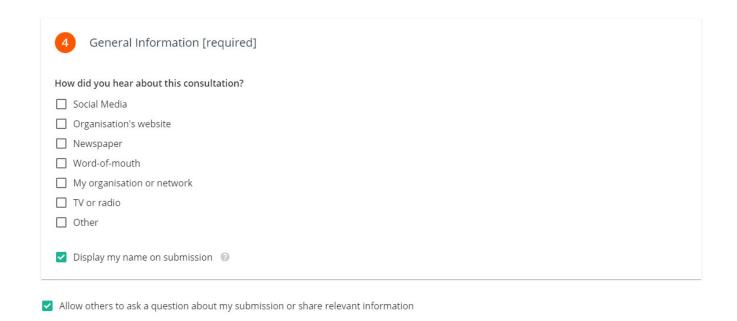
