### **CORK CITY ROAD TRAFFIC (SPECIAL SPEED LIMITS) BYE-LAWS 2020**

Take notice that Cork City Council proposes to make the above-entitled Bye-Laws, setting Special Speed Limits in respect of public roads within the City of Cork in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 9 of the Road Traffic Act 2004 as amended by Section 22 of the Road Traffic Act 2016.

### **CORK CITY APPOINTED STANDS (TAXI) BYE-LAWS 2020**

Take notice that Cork City Council proposes to make the above-entitled Bye-Laws in respect of Appointed Stands (taxi ranks) within the City of Cork in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 25 of the Taxi Regulation Act 2013 as amended by Section 2 of the Public Transport Act 2016.

A copy of the draft Cork City Road Traffic (Special Speed Limits) Bye-Laws 2020 and the draft Cork City Appointed Stands (Taxi) Bye Laws 2020 will be available for public inspection during the period of Friday the 29<sup>th</sup> of November 2019 to Monday the 06<sup>th</sup> January 2020 between the hours of 9am and 5pm at the Reception Desk, City Hall, Anglesea Street, Cork.
